

Aspire Sixth Form Learning Contract

The aim of Aspire Sixth is to achieve good results in examinations, gain entry to Higher Education/Apprenticeships or better employment prospects and to continue to grow into a well rounded individual.

If the schools are to be successful in helping you achieve your potential, then it is important you fulfil certain obligations.

Therefore, you are being asked to enter into a contract by agreeing to fulfil the expectations requested.

The learner agrees to contribute to their own learning and development by:

- Attending school from 8:35am until 3:00pm (unless an offsite pass is awarded for 'free' time)
- Attending all lessons regularly and on time
- Maintaining overall attendance at 96% as a minimum (seeking 100% where possible)
- Studying at least 3 A Levels courses (or equivalent)
- Arriving prepared for all lessons (bringing the required materials and equipment)
- Meeting all examination and coursework requirements on time
- Using study periods purposefully
- Doing all work beyond lessons which is set to develop a wider understanding of the subject
- Ensuring that any part-time work commitments do not interfere with academic studies
- Following the <u>professional dress code</u> at all times in school
- Taking responsibility of any resources loaned by the school
- Ensuring any changes to any individual Programme of Study are first negotiated with parents, pastoral and/or teaching staff
- Attending regular action planning and review sessions if necessary
- Assuming responsible and sensible standards of behaviour both in respect of other students, staff, the wider community and the Sixth Form areas

You are expected to complete a minimum of four hours of independent learning per subject per week in addition to your lessons.

If you do not consistently meet Aspire Sixth's expectations or it is felt you do not make reasonable progress you may be invited to with your parents to discuss your future at Aspire Sixth Form
